Grief Care and Support

In recognition that, often, our grief needs time and space to be acknowledged, Lychgate Funerals offers bereavement support to assist in this process.

Gaining support and talking with someone outside our immediate circle can help us alleviate some of the feelings associated with grief and assist us by helping us understand *how* grief affects us.

A death in any circumstance is an upheaval, both emotionally and practically, sometimes we find that we need to make decisions and adjustments which are unfamiliar to us.

It can be of tremendous reassurance having someone listen to us at a vulnerable time.



How can Lychgate help?

Whilst we all experience loss differently, it is most commonly during the period after the funeral, when friends and family have returned to their daily routines that we find ourselves struggling to adjust and cope.

Our grief care and support service includes making contact after the funeral to offer a listening ear and discuss whether this service might be of help at this time.

Is there a charge for our service?

We believe bereavement support to be an integral part of our service to families and to that end there is no charge for two sessions. If you would like continued support after that, we can discuss your individual needs and look at options together.



Who can use our bereavement support?

Any member of a family who has used Lychgate for the funeral arrangements for their loved one. We will automatically contact you in the month following the funeral but you are also very welcome to contact us at any time.



What can you expect from our service?

- To be listened to
- To be treated with care and respect
- To have your feelings acknowledged
- To gain an understanding of your grief
- Confidentiality
